1. Every week payment £8 an hour, £16 every lesson of 2 hours.
2. Advance payment of 5 weeks, £7.50 an hour, £15 every lesson of 2 hours.
3. Advance payment of 10 weeks, £7 an hour, £14 every lesson of 2 hours.
4. Advance payment of 20 weeks, £6.50 an hour, £13 every lesson of 2 hours.
5. For 11+, every week payment £12 an hour, advance payment of 5 weeks, £11 an hour 10 weeks, £10.50 an hour, advance payment of 20 weeks, £9 an hour.

### GCSE Year 9, Year 10 & Year 11

1. Every week payment £9 an hour, £18 every lesson of 2 hours.
2. The commitment is that you'll pay even if the student misses the lesson due to any reason. In case of missing, the student will get compensation lessons in term holidays or in exam leave in case of advance notice of 24 hours. You'll pay £240 for 5 weeks.
3. Advance payment of 10 weeks, £8.50 an hour, £17 every lesson of 2 hours.
4. If you want to cancel the tuition before committed weeks, the money will be refunded by charging £9 an hour for the attended lessons.

## A-LEVELS

1. Every week payment £15 an hour.
2. Advance payment of 5 weeks, £13 an hour.
3. Advance payment of 10 weeks, £12 an hour.
4. Advance payment of 20 weeks, £11 an hour.

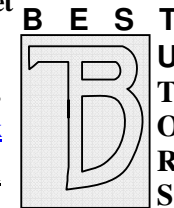

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. In case of missing the lesson without any notice or a notice less than 24 hours, you'll pay even if the student misses the lesson due to any reason.
2. In case of missing with advance notice of 24 hours, the student will get compensation lessons in term holidays or in exam leave or in any other convenient time at which both parties are agreed.
3. In case of missing the lesson with one week notice, the lesson will be cancelled and no money will be charged or the money will be transferred to the following week but only for 2 weeks every year.
4. The deposit money will be refunded with a 2 week notice.
5. If you want to cancel the tuition before committed weeks, the money will be refunded by charging £7 an hour for the attended lessons for under GCSE and £10 an hour for GCSE and £12 an hour for A-Level and 11+ classes.
6. If the child misses 3 weeks without notice the registration will be cancelled and the deposit money will not be refunded.
7. The students are required to bring their own stationery, i.e. pen, pencil, ruler, eraser, sharpener, calculator, lined paper etc.
8. In case of missing 3 weeks or more, there is no guarantee that the student will be able to get the place back as our waiting list is very long and as soon as someone leaves we have to give the place to the next waiting person. Since we charge very low fees, hence we cannot wait for missing students.
9. If ½ rate for the missing lessons is paid before leaving, we can definitely keep the place for the student and half of the missing hours will be compensated in coming holidays.
10. If the fee is not paid on committed time, the full fee as described on the brochure per week will be charged rather than the discounted rate.
11. The ID card is issued for £2, in case of loss new one is issued for £2. In case of not bringing the ID card, the student can be taken out of the class of £1 will be charged for the management to check the record of registration.
